 - Completed Supporting Family Application (form attached) – if applicable.
 - Birth Certificate.
 - Baptismal and First Communion Certificates (if child received sacraments).
 - Report Card and/or Progress Reports (most recent).
 - Standardized Test Scores (most recent) - does not apply to grades 1 and 2.
 - Completed NCEA Survey (form attached).
 - Completed Religious Education Questionnaire (form attached).
2. Please include a **non-refundable** application/testing fee of \$100.00 (per application).
3. Please ask your child's current teacher to fill out the enclosed **Student Assessment Form** and return it to Queen of Apostles School. The school's address is printed on the bottom of the assessment form.
4. **Please call school office with any questions or to set up for tours @ (408) 252-3659**
5. If your child is accepted and we have space available, you will be given registration papers to fill out and return, as well as further information about our school. At this time, a non-refundable registration fee is requested. (The registration fee for the 2016/2017 school year is \$625.00.)
