

FEES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Following is information regarding Queen of Apostles School. Tuition and fees have not been determined for the 2017-18 school year and are subject to change. The fees and payment schedule listed below are for the 2016-17 school year.

TUITION

There are three payment options available. The three methods are a single payment for the full tuition, two payments or by automatic withdrawal monthly. Tuition that is paid monthly will be accepted only by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) in **10 monthly** payments from July through April. **The 2016-17 tuition rates are as follows:**

Supporting families of the parish are those who, qualify via the application for supporting in-parish tuition rates. The Supporting Family Application Form must be signed and returned to register as a supporting family.

EXTENDED CARE

Queen of Apostles provides before school care from 6:30 A.M. to 7:45 A.M. and after school care from dismissal until 6:00 P.M. Activities include outdoor recreation, organized games, study hall, snack, arts and crafts, movies, and board games. Full time participants have four payment options of either a single payment for the full tuition, two Semi-Annual payments, Monthly by automatic withdrawal ; or at the end of the month (hourly). Monthly payments are made **10 months** per year. The yearly family registration fee for this school year was \$50.00. The following are the rates applicable to the 2016/2017 school year and are subject to change:

ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fees for the following school year are due in April for students who are already enrolled in our school. This fee is paid for a new student as part of his/her registration process. For new students coming for the new school year the registration fee is holding a place for your child.

PAC Fundraiser Participation

Each family is required to participate in annual PAC fundraisers and generate at least a \$500 contribution to the school. Contributions are only tracked and accumulated through (any combination of) the "Major Five" fundraisers: Auction, Magazine Drive, Apples to Apples Sales, Walk-a-Thon and the Scrip Program. Fundraiser contributions will be determined as described in Attachment A. In June, the \$500 contribution goal less the contributions generated and tracked throughout the year will be invoiced.

ADMISSIONS

When students score equally on testing, acceptance will be determined by the Principal and teacher based on eligibility, teacher recommendations, and the ability of the school to help the student to succeed. Priority is given to siblings of current students, and registered families that support the parish.

KINDERGARTEN ADMISSION

Children must be five years of age by September 1st of the school year they wish to be admitted. The applicant must also demonstrate that he/she is developmentally ready as determined by the data compiled as a result of screening by the Kindergarten teacher(s).

AFTER SCHOOL SPORTS

Queen of Apostles has a very well planned after school sports program for all interested students in Grades 5 - 8. Students participate in the Diocese of San Jose League, Central Division. A sports fee is payable prior to the first practice of the season. Girls' sports are volleyball, basketball, and softball. Boys' sports are flag football, basketball, and volleyball.

PARENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

All parents of Queen of Apostles School are members of this organization. The Committee assists the school by arranging fund raising and social activities for our school community. All parents are expected to help the Committee with fund raising.

SERVICE TASKS

Families choose how to provide 40 hours of volunteer service to Queen of Apostles School as follows:

Category A - Jobs earn an automatic 40 hours of service

Category B - Jobs earn an automatic 20 hours of service

Category C - Jobs are credited by the hour

Category D - A donation of \$600 may be made to the Parent Advisory Committee.
